



CACHE Dashboard – Overview













Alaska Core Competency #1

Learn basic competencies to effectively work with others.

The Alaska Core Competencies are a set of essential skills for DSPs (direct support providers or direct support professionals) who deliver services to persons with mental health and substance use conditions, intellectual and physical disabilities, and older adults who need long-term services and support. There are 10 broad competency categories which are broken down into 42 individual competencies, and then each competency is defined by behavioral descriptors. This is a unique feature which allows workers to understand what it looks like to perform at the Excellent, Satisfactory, and Unsatisfactory levels.

This training will cover Alaska Core Competency #1: Working with Others

- Listens Effectively
- Communicates Effectively
- Builds Positive Relationships
- Collaborates
- Maintains Appropriate Boundaries

DSP Pilot Program trainings are reserved for the pre-assigned cohort members. Registration will be opened to the public if seats are available.
