## Part-time MSW Program Costs: 2013-2014 Academic Year

Students enrolled in the UAA MSW program pay graduate tuition which for the 2013-2014 academic year is \$391 per graduate credit for state residents, \$799 per graduate credit for non-residents. There is no 'tuition cap' so students pay for all credits for which they have enrolled during a semester.

Please note that increases in tuition take effect each Fall semester, for the academic year. Costs will therefore differ between each summer and the following fall and spring semesters.

Costs per semester for students enrolled in the part-time UAA MSW program will be determined by the number of course credits required by their Graduate Studies Plans. The example that follows is based on typical first-year Foundation student plan, which will involve enrollment in one three-credit course during summer semester and in two courses, for a total of six credits, during each fall and spring semester. Alaska residency is assumed.

Tuition is reviewed by the Board of Regents each year and is subject to increase by their action. Increases of varying percentages have been applied during the past several years.

The UAA MSW program is a participant in the WICHE Western Regional Graduate Program (WRGP). - As students progress through the program, costs will differ from the above depending on such factors as annual tuition adjustments and the number and source of elective courses included in the program
