Lt Col Jessica A. Tompkins is the commander of the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps Detachment 001 in Anchorage, Alaska. She is responsible for overseeing the preparation and training of officer candidates through a comprehensive college program at the University of Alaska and three cross-town universities.

Lt Col Tompkins received her commission in 2006 as a graduate of the Reserve Officer Training Corps and was then assigned to Eglin Air Force Base as a Developmental Engineer. While at Eglin AFB, she served as an A-10 Test Engineer and air-to-surface weapons Test Engineer. She then deployed in support of Operation IRAQI FREEDOM to Joint Base Balad, Iraq and served as the theater Joint Combat Assessment Team Lead before being accepted to the United States Air Force Test Pilot School (TPS), After graduating TPS as a Flight Test Engineer, she served again at Eglin AFB where she led the 80+ member Combat Air Forces Command and Control Test Flight as Flight Commander. Lt Col Tompkins then served at the Space and Missile Systems Center at Los Angeles Air Force Base, California in the Remote Sensing Systems Directorate. She then went on to teach multivariate calculus as a Senior Instructor in the Department of Mathematical Sciences at the United States Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs, Colorado.



Prior to her current assignment, Lt Col Tompkins served as the Deputy Group Commander of the 412th Operations Group, Edwards Air Force Base, California. The 412th Operations Group is the Air Force's largest Flight Test Operations Group and is responsible for executing over 300 test programs on 76 aircraft of 12 different types, both manned and remotely piloted.
