Technical Sergent Andrew P. Barker serves as the Non-Commissioned Officer In Charge of Personnel of the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps at the University of Alaska Anchorage. He is responsible for the overall management of personnel records for cadre and cadets. He also oversees all actions regarding cadet life cycle operations to include medical, physical, enlistment, categorization, and commissioning.

Sergeant Barker entered the Air Force in August of 2013 and graduated from the Louis F. Garland Department of Defense Fire Academy at Goodfellow AFB, Texas in February of 2014. He spent his first six years of service in his hometown, stationed at Little Rock AFB, Arkansas. While there, he deployed twice to Iraq and Kuwait in support of operation INHERENT RESOLVE. Sergeant Barker also volunteered for a remote assignment to Clear AFS, Alaska where he served as the NCOIC of Fire Prevention and Logistics. During this time, he oversaw the flight's annual budget and drove the acceptance testing for the Long Range Discrimination Radar, a priority level one missile defense system. Following this assignment, Seargeant Barker deployed a third time to Niger in support of operation ENDURING FREEDOM-JUNIPER SHIELD. Prior to his current position, Sergeant Barker was the Assistant Chief of Operations at Ellsworth AFB, South Dakota where he provided Incident Command for a host of emergencies both on-base and in the surrounding communities.
