

Articulation Agreement

The below table shows students transferring from Alaska Christian College (ACC) to the University of Alaska Anchorage (UAA), the University of Alaska Fairbanks (UAF), or the University of Alaska Southeast (UAS) how general education courses completed at ACC will be recognized at each UA institution. UAA, UAF and UAS are separately accredited by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU). Alaska Christian College is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation of the Association for Biblical Higher Education (ABHE). ABHE is recognized by both the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) and the U.S. Department of Education. ACC is authorized by the Alaska Commission on Postsecondary Education, which establishes expectations for areas such as faculty qualifications and the categories required for the general education component of an Associate degree.

Requirements

1. The above shows how individual courses transfer to UAA, UAF, and UAS. Students must have earned a C or above in a course at ACC for the course to transfer to UAA, UAF, or UAS.
2. Students must be academically eligible for re-admission to Alaska Christian College.
3. Students must meet student conduct requirements of UAA, UAF, or UAS.
4. Students must meet all application requirements at UAA, UAF, or UAS including the submission of all required documentation by stated deadlines.

Terms

1. This articulation agreement will be valid for 5 years from the date of signing, at which point it may be renewed by mutual agreement.
2. UAA, UAF, UAS or ACC may terminate this agreement upon 90 days signed, written notice to the other partners. In the event of termination, the articulation agreement will apply to any students already admitted to UAA/UAF/UAS, and the Parties will make good faith efforts to accommodate students in the process of applying and being admitted to UAA/UAF/UAS.
3. The agreement may be revised/modified by mutual agreement as needed or requested, or in the event of a curriculum change or cancellation, discontinuance, or disapproval of any of the courses or programs.
4. UAA, UAF, UAS, and ACC may advertise this agreement and advise students that this option is available to them.
5. UAA, UAF, UAS, and ACC will confer annually to consider the articulation agreement in the context of student benefits, program efficiency, and effectiveness.
6. UAA, UAF, UAS, and ACC agree to notify the other partners of any adverse changes in their accreditation, licensure, or Alaska state authorization status.


