FOCUS 2 Session Codes and Scheduling Guidance

Updated December 12, 2022

The UA System began using new session codes in spring 2023 – F,O,C,U,S (instead of 0,1,2,3) to more clearly identify course delivery methods and define clear expectations for students.

- **F** In Person (Instruction is face to face at a physical location)
- **O** Online No Set Time (Completely online with no mandatory set meeting time)
- **C** In Person **and** Online (Combination of face to face and required online instruction)
- **U** In Person **or** Online (Option to participate in class sessions face to face or online)
- **S** Online Set Time (Completely online at a mandatory set time)

- If multiple CRNs have been approved, the following section note is required for FERPA compliance: "This course is offered concurrently with another section of the same course." OR "This course is offered concurrently with another course."

Some of the new codes will align with the previous classification of sections.

Face-to-face sections without an online component that were "Traditional->50% location based" are now an **F** "In Person" section.

Online only sections that were "0% location-based" are now either **O** "Online - No Set Time", or **S** "Online - Set Time" depending on asynchronous (no set time) or synchronous (set time) requirements.

These new codes shift emphasis away from estimated percentage of instruction tied to a location (1-20% location-based or 21-50% location-based) and instead help students identify classes that offer both distance and face-to-face components, and classes that offer more flexibility.

C "In Person and Online" defines a section with a physical and online meeting pattern. The student is expected to attend each meeting as they are scheduled.

U "In Person or Online" allows the student the option to attend meetings in person or online at their own discretion.
