Nontraditional Credit National Examinations: UAA Equivalencies Department Form

Admitted, degree-seeking UAA students may be awarded credit for learning that is documented with the completion of a national exam, such as AP, IB, CLEP or DSST. The Office of Academic Affairs will provide the program with information about the specific exams, and program faculty determine how these exams will be recognized with academic credit at UAA. UAA follows ACE recommendations wherever possible, and faculty will be informed of these as part of the review process. *Faculty are asked to coordinate with their colleagues at all relevant UAA campuses, and with their colleagues at UAF and UAS, before submitting this form for approval.*

The department chair submits this form. Once approved by the dean and OAA, OAA will file the form with the Registrar at uaa.transfer@alaska.edu and copy Governance. It will be an informational item on the next agenda for the appropriate curriculum board. The decision will be implemented immediately, and the Registrar will update the next catalog with the information. When there are changes to the exam or the UAA course(s), the department will revisit the equivalency.
