The department chair submits this form. Once approved by the dean and OAA, OAA will file the form with the Registrar at <a href="mailto:uaa.transfer@alaska.edu">uaa.transfer@alaska.edu</a> and copy Governance. It will be an informational item on the next agenda for the appropriate curriculum board. The decision will be implemented immediately, and the Registrar will update the next catalog with the information. When there are changes to the exam or the UAA course(s), the department will revisit the equivalency.
