What is Student Support Services?

Student Support Services (SSS) is a federally funded program designed to provide academic assistance and enhance educational opportunities for students. Federal guidelines require students to be from low-income families, first-generation college students, and/or experience a documented disability. Students must also have an academic need for our program. The program is designed to work with students throughout their academic career at the University of Alaska Anchorage until a baccalaureate degree is attained.

This program is offered free of charge to participants.

Eligibility is based on federally defined criteria:

- Students who meet low-income qualifications
- Students whose parents have not earned a bachelor's degree
- Individuals who experience a documented disability

SSS participants must be:

- U.S. citizens, permanent residents, or individuals who meet the residency requirements for Federal student financial assistance
- Admitted and enrolled at the University of Alaska Anchorage
- Pursuing first bachelor's degree
- Needing academic support
- Committed to utilizing academic support to earn a four-year degree

Application Process:

- Complete and return this application to TRIO Student Support Services (in-person or mail to SSS office or via email)
- Schedule and complete an initial meeting and intake process with the SSS Director or a Retention Coordinator
